

Announcement of Periodic Review: Moody's Ratings announces completion of a periodic review of ratings of Seine-et-Marne, Departement de

Paris, May 24, 2024 -- Moody's Ratings (Moody's) has completed a periodic review of the ratings of Seine-et-Marne, Departement de and other ratings that are associated with this issuer.

The review was conducted through a rating committee held on 17 May 2024 in which Moody's reassessed the appropriateness of the ratings in the context of the relevant principal methodology(ies), and recent developments.

Key Rating considerations and rationale are summarized below.

Seine-et-Marne, Departement de 's ratings, including its aa3 baseline credit assessment (BCA) and Aa3 long-term issuer rating, with stable outlook, reflect a track record of strong operating performance that provides shock absorption capacity, debt deleveraging resulting in a moderate debt burden and its strong governance and financial management. The ratings also reflect the local government's limited financial flexibility like all French départements. The ratings factor in Moody's assessment of a moderate likelihood of extraordinary support from the Government of France (Aa2 stable) in the event that the local government faces extreme liquidity stress.

This document summarizes Moody's view as of the publication date and will not be updated until the next periodic review announcement, which will incorporate material changes in credit circumstances (if any) during the intervening period.
